1. **Executive Session:**

Subsequent to a roll call vote in Regular Session on a motion made by Ellen Grieco, seconded by Jeanne Downs, the School Committee voted unanimously (5-0) to enter Executive Session at 10:33 p.m. to discuss and possibly approve the ratification of the Food Service Memorandum of Agreement and vote to authorize the Chair to sign the Memorandum of Agreement, as permitted by M.G.L. c.30A, §21(a) (3), as such discussion in open meeting may have a detrimental effect on the bargaining position of the School Committee and an Executive Session is necessary to protect the bargaining position of the School Committee; discuss three residency matters, pursuant to M.G.L. c.30A, §21(a)(7), in order to comply with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 20 U.S.C. §1232g and the Massachusetts Right to Privacy Law, M.G.L. c.214, §1B; discuss Open Meeting Law Complaints filed by George Harris on July 7, 2017 alleging insufficient detail in Executive Session minutes, July 18, 2017 alleging failure to produce minutes, both in violation of M.G.L. c.30A, §22, and September 19, 2017 alleging insufficient detail in agenda in violation of M.G.L., c.30A, §20, and September 28, 2017 alleging failure to produce minutes in a timely manner in violation of M.G.L. c.30A, §22, and November 3, 2017 alleging that proper procedure was not followed in responding to a previous Open Meeting Law complaint in violation of M.G.L. c.30A, §23(b); and approval of the following Executive Session minutes, as permitted by M.G.L. c.30A, §22: November 20, 2017.
